The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.44 dated 08.06.2020 registered under Sections 498A/406 IPC at Women Police Station, U.T., Chandigarh.

At the very outset, learned counsel appearing for the State submits that after investigation petitioners No.1 and 2 have been found innocent.

In view of the above statement the present petition qua petitioners No.1 and 2 is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

So far as petitioner No.3 is concerned, since it is not disputed that investigation in the FIR in question is still going on, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.3, at this stage, with liberty to petitioner No.3 to make a detailed

representation with regard to her grievances before the investigation officer.

Dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.3 with liberty as prayed for with a further direction to the Investigating Officer in the FIR in question that in case petitioner No.3, within one week from today, makes any representation to him/her, he/she shall consider the same before completion of the investigation.
