AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

Present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to entrust the investigation of the case FIR No.184 dated 16.10.2021 registered at Police Station City 2 Mansa, District Mansa under Section 306 IPC to some high ranking police officer.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 03.03.2022, pursuant thereto status report dated 11.10.2022 by way of affidavit of Sanjeev Goyal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Mansa, District Mansa had been filed.

Learned State counsel makes a reference to paras 7 and 8 of the status report, which read thus:-

“That during the investigation of the present case FIR, it was found that Arshdeep Singh was under major depression and he was getting treatment from Dr. Manoj Goyal, Goyal

Physchiatric Hospital, Mansa. "Cyber Crime, Mohali (in the form of pendrive) of conversation between Arshdeep Singh with above named Udesb Sharma, the fact proving the depression suffered by Arshdeep is well proved, which clarifies that Arshdeep Singh has not committed suicide, due to harassmt caused by accused Sukhdeep Kaur @ Sukhpreet Kaur.

8. That during the investigation of the present case FIR, no such, strict or cogent evidence has came on the police file, which could incriminate Sukhdeep Kaur @ Sukhpreet Kaur or link the accused with the commission of offence. On 10.08.2022, recommendation was made by the investigating officer to cancel the present case FIR and the same was forwarded to higher police authorities for the purpose of consideration as such, arrest of accused Sukhdeep Kaur @ Sukhpreet Kaur is not required to the police, at this stage."

In view of the aforesaid, learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case.

Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail of alternate remedy, available to her, in accordance with law.
