1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 06.01.2020, in CRM-M-55189-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M-55189-2019, was disposed of vide order dated 06.01.2020, by directing the respondent to look into and decide representation filed by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, refers to order Annexure R/3 dated 07.04.2020, as per which, representation filed by the petitioner has been decided and cancellation report filed.

4. Notice has not yet been issued in this case.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of speaking order Annexure R/3, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to file protest petition before the learned trial Court, against the

cancellation report, filed pursuant to order Annexure R/3.

6. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
