1. Though from a reading of the report of the learned Illaqa Magistrate, it is clear that the compromise, as drawn, and, depended upon by all the concerned, is genuinely recorded. However, it is also reported to this Court, that after conclusion of prosecution evidence, and, after recording of the accused's statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C., the matter is pending, before the learned Magistrate concerned, for adduction of defence evidence, and, for arguments on 17.2.2022. Therefore, the petition, as preferred before this Court, for quashing of FIR No. 0228 of 7.11.2017, registered at Police Station Chhansa, District Faridabad, at this stage, is not amenable for being allowed. Accordingly, it is permitted to be withdrawn.

2. Dismissed as withdrawn.

3. It is open to the learned counsel for the petitioner to re-approach this Court, at an appropriate stage.
