Grievance of the petitioner *inter alia* is qua non compliance of instructions dated 25.02.2019 (Annexure P-4), wherein vide clause 3.3 governing ***Effecting Reservation – Roster Point***, it is stated as below :-

“ 3.3 Where in any recruitment year any vacancy earmarked for EWS cannot be filled up due to non availability of a suitable candidate belonging to EWS, such vacancies for that particular recruitment year shall not be carried forward to the next recruitment year as backlog and will be filled from unreserved category.”

2. Without adverting much on the merits on the case, on a Court query with regard to the compliance of aforesaid instructions, learned State counsel under instructions of Sh. Ramneesh, Legal Assistant in the O/o HSSC submits that appropriate steps are already being taken to convert the posts meant for EWS category into General category, since the suitable EWS candidates could not be found. The needful will be done in due course and in case, the petitioner is found meritorious in the General category qua the aforesaid EWS posts, his candidature would be considered in accordance with law and appropriate orders will be passed.

3. In view of the aforesaid, no further writ proceedings are required before this Court. The petition is disposed of with expectation from the respondents that appropriate steps would be taken as expeditiously as possible not later than two months from today.

4. Disposed of accordingly.
