SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Since the learned State counsel, on instructions given to him by ASI Balbir Singh, submits, that after completion of investigation into the petition offences, the investigating officer concerned, has filed a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., before the learned Court concerned, besides his further submitting that thereafter, upon drawing of charges against the accused, the prosecution evidence has commenced.

2. Therefore, when the investigations are complete, and, also when the trial has commenced, before the learned Court concerned, hence the prayer made in the instant petition for transfer of investigation from the agency, which conducted and completed them, to some other agency, is not amenable for becoming accepted.

3. There is no merit in the petition, and, is hereby dismissed.
