Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.67 dated 16.3.2021, registered under Sections 354-A(1)(i), 450, 506 IPC and Section 10 of POCSO Act, 2012 (Sections 376(AB) 376(2)(n), 342 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO, Act added and Sections 354-A, 450 IPC and Section 10 of POCSO Act, deleted) at Police Station Uklana, Disstrict Hisar.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition at this stage. However, he submits that the petitioner is suffering from Cancer and as such a proper medical treatment may kindly be provided to him.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage. So far as the prayer regarding medical treatment of the petitioner is concerned, learned State counsel has submitted that he is duly being examined at PGIMS, Rohtak. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on some specific dates, the petitioner was not taken to hospital

The prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner regarding providing medical care to the petitioner, cannot be ignored.

The Jail Authorities are directed to provide the best of the medical care available to the petitioner and continue the same as per the medical prescription of PGIMS, Rohtak and to ensure the compliance of this order in letter and spirit.
