This is the second petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.122 dated 24.10.2014, under Sections 302, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further made a prayer that in case, the petitioner surrenders before the police within a period of two weeks from today and files an application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of five days from the date of filing of the said application.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

In case, the petitioner surrenders before the police within a period of two weeks from today and files an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court is requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of five days from the date of filing of the said application.
