The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the family pension to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.04.2013 under the old Family Pension Rules of Punjab Civil Services Rules Volume II under the Financial Assistance to the Dependant of the Deceased Government Employees, Rules, 2006 and in terms of letter dated 23.08.2010 and release the arrears of pension along with interest; along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-10) served by the petitioner, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has submitted that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondents are directed to take a conscious decision upon the legal notice dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-10) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioner is found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioner within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
