This petition has been filed against order dated 08.01.2020 (Annexure P-2) whereby property of petitioner was provisionally attached, order dated 31.8.2021 passed by adjudicating authority confirming the attachment order (Annexure P-8) and eviction notice dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-10).

2. The limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that against the impugned order the petitioner has filed an appeal before the appellate Tribunal but the Tribunal is not functional and has prayed the impugned order be kept in abeyance till the appellate authority decides the application for stay.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance notice, Mr. Satya Pal Jain, Additional Solicitor General of India with Ms. Sharmila Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel appears on behalf of the respondent-UOI and has fairly accepted that the Tribunal is still not functional.

5. In these circumstances, no coercive action will be taken against the petitioner till such time the application for stay is taken up and decided by the appellate Tribunal whenever the Tribunal starts functioning.

6. Petition stands disposed of in above terms.

7. Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
