This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the petition dated 28.12.2021 (Annexure P-11) submitted by the petitioner under Section 117 (2) of Border Security Force Act, 1968 against the order of punishment dated 15.9.2021 (Annexure P-7), as informed to the petitioner through letter dated 15.9.2021 (Annexure P-9), received by the petitioner on 24.12.2021, as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Dhiraj Jain, Senior Counsel for UOI, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and, on instructions, submits that none of the officers is against the petitioner as such. The statutory petition filed by the petitioner is, otherwise also, likely to be decided within a period of three months.

In view of the above statement, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be so grateful to the respondent authorities if they take a decision on the petition and consider his case sympathetically. Still

further, since the counsel for the respondents has made a statement that the petition of the petitioner is likely to be decided by the respondents within a period of three months, therefore, the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

The petitioner is permitted to withdraw the same.
