MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking directions to the respondents for tracing his minor daughter, who had been kidnapped by accused persons on 02.02.2022 who are classmates of his daughter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that subsequent to the registration of FIR No.0057 dated 02.02.2022 under Section 365 IPC at Police Station Kanina, District Mahendergarh (Annexure P-2), the petitioner has been getting extortion calls from different numbers asking him to pay money to get his daughter back. He submits that though representations (Annexures P-3 to P-6) had been given to the respondents, however, they had been sitting over the matter and had failed to take any steps to get his daughter recovered or even apprehend the accused. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the authorities concerned to look into his representations and take immediate steps with respect to the FIR in question.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh at Narnaul to look into the representations (Annexures P-3 to to P-6) and take appropriate steps as may be required in accordance with law at the earliest preferably within four weeks from today.
