The petitioner has constructed a shop on Panchayat land allegedly with the permission of the Panchayat as his private land had been encroached upon by the Panchayat. Now, an order of eviction has been passed against him and he has submitted a representation dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) for giving him time to construct his shop on his own land which has been encroached upon by the Panchayat. Accordingly, the said land would require to be demarcated and possession to be handed over to the petitioner. Based upon the representation, the Deputy Commissioner, Panipat has issued directions to the concerned BDPO to take appropriate action. However, nothing has been done and thus, the writ petition has been filed.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

3. Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana-respondents No.1 to 3 and waives service.

4. Considering the nature of the order being passed no reply is necessary.
5. The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to implement the directions of the Deputy Commissioner, Panipat issued vide memo dated 24.11.2021 (Annexure P-7) within six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
