Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covil-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing the cross case registered vide GD No.39 dated 23.11.2019 under sections 341, 324, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station, Haibowal District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana in FIR No.266 dated 19.11.2019 under sections 341, 323, 324, 506, 427, 148, 149 I.P.C (later on sections 325, 326, 354-A IPC were added), registered at Police Station, Haibowal District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 3.12.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that this is a cross case of the above said FIR.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rakeshinder Singh Sidhu, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that investigation is pending and challan is yet to be presented in the present case. He further submits that the investigating agency would conclude the investigation expeditiously and preferably within a period of one month from today.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail alternate remedies as available to them in accordance with law. Liberty is also granted to the petitioners to approach this Court again if need so arises at the appropriate stage.
