This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR no.289 dated 11.09.2020 registered under Sections 420 and 120B IPC at Police Station Derabassi, District SAS Nagar and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bhupinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner which is the company, has not been made an accused in the FIR.
