SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life of the petitioner from danger at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 8 and to take remedial action on the complaints (Annexure P-3 and P-4) made by the petitioner.

At the very outset, learned Counsel for the petitioner would contend that the petitioner had moved two complaints dated 14.01.2022 and 17.01.2022 before the concerned authorities but his grievances have not been looked into and further prays for issuance of directions for protection of his life from danger at the hands of private respondents who are adamant to kill the petitioner.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. Amreek Singh Narwal, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 and he has no objection if

appropriate direction for providing requisite protection to the petitioner is given.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Ambala, District Ambala to look into the grievances of the petitioners as set out in the petition and also expressed in the complaints/representations (Annexures P-3 and P-4) and decide the same in accordance with law, within one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order and also to take appropriate action for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner as may be warranted by the circumstances.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representations (Annexure P-3 and P-4) to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Ambala for requisite compliance.
