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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 167 dated 21.8.2021 registered under Sections 379 B, 506 IPC at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

As per allegations in FIR, petitioner alongwith co accused Manpreet Singh alias Manna and Gurpreet Singh came to a petrol pump on a motorcycle on 13.8.2021. They not only got fuel filled for which they refused to pay but also snatched a sum of Rs. 1700/- from the Pump Operator. They went away issuing threat to Pump Operator.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner has been in custody since 12.9.2021. The matter has also been compromised with the complainant.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the investigation in case is complete and challan has been presented and that petitioner is also involved in three other cases.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and also bearing in mind the fact that the matter, as stated by learned counsel for petitioner has been compromised with the complainant coupled with the custody period and also the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, in my opinion, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars.

Hence, petition is allowed. Petitioner Gursewak Singh alias Gaggi is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail, if petitioner is found involved misusing concession of bail, in any manner or is involved in any other case of similar nature.
