Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.168 dated 19.12.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to the order dated 20.02.2020, the petitioners have joined investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
