The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 30.03.2017, registered under Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali)

At the outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Supinder Singh, has stated that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 01.09.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the specific stand taken by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that in case the petitioner is sought

to be arrested, he shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
