The trial court has refused to the attach the property of the defendants before the final judgment. Questioning its correctness, the plaintiff has filed the present revision petition. The plaintiff claims that her husband, who unfortunately died, has paid Rs.27,00,000/- to the defendants for renovating their farm house but the defendants have failed to fulfill their obligation.

On the other hand, the defendants have pleaded that certain work has already been carried out and they are prepared to carry out the remaining work, however, the plaintiff has already disposed of the farm house.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the trial court, in exercise of its discretionary jurisdiction, has dismissed the application.

Heard the learned counsel representing the parties at length and with their able assistance perused the paperbook. There are disputed questions of fact, which are required to be decided by leading evidence.

In the facts of the case, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere

with the order passed.

Hence, dismissed.

However, if the plaintiff files an application for grant of interim injunction, the court shall decide the same in accordance with law.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
