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**JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)**

The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to exempt the petitioner from appearing in the Physical Screening Test and to keep one seat reserved for her or in the alternative to extend the time for Physical Screening Test scheduled to be held, as the petitioner was pregnant at the relevant time.

The case as set up by the petitioner herein is that she had qualified the written examination for the post of Female Constable (General Duty) in the advertisement No.3/2018 dated 16.04.2018, however, on account of her pregnancy, she was unable to give the Physical Screening Test on the date fixed.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Yogender Sharma, Deputy Superintendent and Mr. Devender Kumar, Assistant, DGP Office,

Panchkula would submit that the petitioner herein was given one more opportunity keeping her pregnancy in mind. It is submitted that the petitioner appeared for the Physical Screening Test, but did not clear the said test.

In view of the fact that the petitioner herein, who was given the second chance has not cleared the Physical Screening Test, learned counsel for the petitioner herein does not press the instant writ petition seeking liberty to either revive the same or to file a fresh one, should there be any reason to do so.

Dismissed as not pressed.
