By way of the instant petition, the petitioner seeks the indulgence of this Court for transferring the investigation of the criminal case registered vide the FIR bearing No.232 dated 19.06.2021 registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 427, 458, 506, 148 and 149 IPC along-with GD No.02 dated 19.06.2021 and GD No.29 dated 23.06.2021 entered at the afore-said Police Station, under Sections 323, 294, 506, 148, 149 IPC (wherein the offence under Section 307 IPC is stated to have been added later-on), to the Bureau of Investigation, Punjab or to the investigating agency outside District SAS Nagar, for being

conducted under the supervision of an IPS officer as so to ensure that the same is conducted in a fair manner.

2. Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Amritpal Singh from Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, apprises the Court that the investigation of the afore-said case has already been transferred to AIG Commission, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh, on 01.06.2022.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, it becomes explicit that the cause of action does not survive any more in favour of the petitioner to pursue this petition further.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed accordingly.
