The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to provide adequate protection to the petitioner who apprehends danger to her life at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 11 and further direction to respondent Nos.4 to 11 not to interfere in the peaceful life and liberty of the petitioner.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The learned State counsel submits that after obtaining divorce from Mukesh Kumar resident of Chandigarh, she has married to Harvinder Singh @ Sukhwinder Singh and is currently residing in Delhi and is untraceable.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved by the conduct of respondents, she is free to avail her remedies in accordance with law.
