1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1), dated 04.09.2019, in CWP No.24279 of 2019.

2. A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.24279 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the Executive Engineer (C), Punjab Mandi Board, Kapurthala to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 03.08.2019 and to take a final decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case it was found that any funds were due, to release the same to the petitioner without any further delay.

3. Learned Counsel states that pursuant to notice issued on 18.02.2020, respondent No.2 has determined the amount payable to the petitioner and in pursuance thereto, payment as per entitlement

determined by respondent No.2 has been released and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent(s) under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
