Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0009 dated 18.01.2021 under Sections 406, 420, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri.

Learned State counsel points out that pursuant to the vacation of the interim order granting stay against arrest of the petitioners on 21.12.2021, the petitioner Satish Kumar Sharma has already been arrested.

The petition qua petitioner No.1 Satish Kumar Sharma has thus been rendered infructuous.

Insofar as the petitioner No.2, Sahil son of Satish Kumar sharma is concerned, it is contended that the said co-accused has joined the

investigation and is nore required on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar for the purpose of investigation in the present case.

In view of the above, the arrest of the petitioner No.2 Sahil son of Satish Kumar sharma shall remain stayed in the present case, subject to conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
