The instant writ petition has been filed seeking to challenge the actions of the respondents denying the appointment to the petitioner herein to the post of Female Constable (General Duty) pursuant to her having applied for the same.

The case as set up by the petitioner herein is that she had qualified the written examination for the post of Female Constable (General Duty) in the advertisement No.3/2018 dated 16.04.2018, but was not able to undergo the Physical Screening Test on account of her pregnancy and, therefore, she had prayed for one more opportunity.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Yogender Sharma, Deputy Superintendent and Mr. Devender Kumar, Assistant, DGP Office, Panchkula would submit that the Physical Screening Test of the petitioner was

conducted afresh and she has qualified the same.

Consequent to the said qualification, the petitioner herein has been offered appointment and is presently working at Karnal.

In the face of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner herein does not press the instant writ petition as the same is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as not pressed.
