The prayer made by the petitioner in the instant writ petition is for issuance of necessary directions to officials respondents No. 1 to 6 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.7 on the complaint dated 18.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) for forging the documents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.7 is the elected Sarpanch of Village Chilli, Tehsil Hathin, District Palwal. He embezzled the grants received for the development of village and also usurp the salary of petitioner's wife who is an elected Member Panchayat from Ward No.10. According to learned counsel, complaint dated 02.09.2019 was made by him to the police detailing all the facts. However, respondent No.7

produced a forged and fabricated affidavit purported to have been sworn by petitioner with the recitals that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and respondent No.7. The petitioner agitated the matter before the authorities by submitting various complaints. Lastly, complaint dated 18.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) was filed by him before respondent No.5, who assigned the same to respondent No.6. But no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG Haryana, who has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 6 on service of advance copy of petition, has accepted the notice. He submits that representation, Annexure P-8 will be looked into by respondent No.5.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to look into the representation (Annexure P-8) and decide the same in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copies of this order and representation (Annexure P-8)

Instant petition stands disposed of with abovesaid observations and directions.
