Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.194 dated 3.11.2019 registered under Sections 306, 201, 34 IPC (Section 302 I.P.C was added later on) at Police Station, Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 10.9.2021, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance to the order dated 10.9.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhbir Singh has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 10.9.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
