Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.0254 dated 18.11.2021 registered under Sections 452, 354, 323, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise deed dated 12.01.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Mr. Amarpreet Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and has filed his 'Power of Attorney', which is taken on record. Counsel has filed an affidavit of the complainant-respondent No.2, wherein, she has deposed as under:-

*“1. That I have registered a FIR No.254 dated 18.11.2021,
P.S.Canal Colony, Bathinda against Ved Parkash, Nirmala*

Devi, Varinder Kumar and Rinku on the basis of real and true facts.

2. That I have got information regarding the quashing proceeding of FIR pending in the Court of Hon'ble High Court under CRM-M-9268 of 2022.

3. That I want to state that I have not done any compromise with the above mentioned accused.

4. That I have not engaged any counsel in the above mentioned case in the High Court.

5. That today I am engaging Advocate Amarpreet Singh to represent me in the above mentioned case.”

In view of the above affidavit of the complainant-respondent No.2, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
