Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 20.01.2020, the petitioner, who was eligible under the said order, had filed an application for the grant of permit on Ambala City to Naraingarh via Handesra route but even though two years have already elapsed but the petitioner is yet to get the response with regard to the application submitted by him. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once the petitioner has filed an application, it becomes the duty of the respondents either to accept or reject the same by giving appropriate reason and in the present case, no order has been conveyed to the petitioner so far, which means that the application submitted by the petitioner in pursuance to the order passed

by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 20.01.2020, is still pending consideration with the respondents, hence, appropriate direction be given to the respondents to decide the said application of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, application is submitted by the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the Department, appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks from today and the same will be conveyed to the petitioner. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, any order has already been passed on the application of the petitioner, same will also be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the grievance of the petitioner, as raised in the present petition, stands redressed and the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
