JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of appropriate writ or direction to respondent No.1 & 2 for protecting life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent Nos.3 to 6.

Notice was issued by this Court and DSP, City-II, Mohali was also directed to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner and the scope of the present petition is confined to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Mr. R.S. Thind, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has stated on instructions from S.I. Naib Singh, that the petitioner had reported

to the DSP, City-II, Mohali and thereafter he has stated that there is no further apprehension to him from anybody and therefore, he does not require any protection.

Mr. Charanpreet Singh, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent Nos.3 & 4 and Mr. Prince Karan Singh, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondent Nos.5 & 6 and they have filed their respective Power of Attorney in Court today. Both the learned counsel for respondent Nos.3 & 4 and 5 & 6 have categorically stated that they have not posed any threat to the petitioner and in future also they will not pose any threat to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned State counsel on instructions from S.I. Naib Singh as well as learned counsel for respondent Nos.3 to 6, he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
