1. FIR No.4 of 01.01.2015, is registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar City, and, constitutes therein offences embodied under Sections 307, 406, 420, 364, 342, 506, 120-B IPC 1860.

2. From the date of registration of the afore FIR in the year 2015, and, also with charges becoming drawn in the year 2016, yet till date the trial has not concluded, thereupon the above delay in the conclusion of the trial, as arises from the afore FIR, appears to be both inordinate as well as *prima-facie* not condonable.

3. Therefore, the learned trial Judge concerned, is directed to within three months hereafter conclude the trial appertaining to the FIR (supra).
