The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the difference of pension after calculating the same on the basis of correct last pay drawn in terms of orders (Annexures P23 and P24), GIS, remaining amount of Commutation of Pension, leave encashment, gratuity and General Provident Fund along with interest @ 18% p.a. on the delayed payment of retiral benefits, as well as 3rd modified ACP and grant all consequential benefits and in alternate to decide the representations dated 22.07.2021 and 16.02.2022 (Annexure P-30 and P-31 respectively).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider the representations dated 22.07.2021 and 16.02.2022 (Annexure P-30 and P-31 respectively) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
