Instant writ petition was filed seeking a mandamus directing the respondents to issue refunds to the petitioner along with interest pursuant to assessment orders dated 30.03.2016 (Annexure P-1) for assessment year 2012-13 as also assessment order dated 30.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) pertaining to the year 2014-15.

On a previous date of hearing i.e. on 17.05.2022, this Court had noticed that as per written statement filed, the refunds in question have since been made over. The only issue as such which survive was the entitlement of the petitioner towards interest on the delayed release of refund for the assessment years 2012-13 and 2014-15.

Mr. Sandeep Goyal, counsel for the petitioner submits that since the main relief already stands granted, he would not be pressing the instant writ petition. He seeks indulgence of this Court that in case a separate claim/representation is filed seeking interest on the delayed release of the refund amount, the same be decided expeditiously and in accordance with law.

We find such submission to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

We, however, direct that in case the petitioner files a claim for interest on the delayed release of refund for the assessment years 2012-13 and 2014-15, the same would be looked into by the competent authority and a decision thereupon would be taken within a period of six weeks from the date of filing of such claim as per law.

It would be appreciated that prior to taking a final view an opportunity of personal hearing is granted to the authorized representative of the petitioner/company.

Disposed of.
