

Balwant Singh and another Versus Jaswinder Singh and others

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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four lakh and fifty thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to appellant No.2 – Jagir Kaur in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. The enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.2 – Jagir Kaur in terms of award rendered by the Tribunal.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque/demand draft for Rs.4,50,000/- in favour of appellant No.2 – Jagir Kaur in terms of award rendered by the Tribunal with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the crossed-cheque/demand draft to learned counsel/ representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
