On 06.04.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“This petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.75 dated 14.08.2021, registered under Sections 306/34 of IPC at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that deceased was wife of the petitioner and they were married for 12 years. He submits that three children were born out of the wedlock, who are in the custody of father of the petitioner. Counsel submits that although allegation has been levelled that the petitioner was harassing the deceased and Panchayat had to intervene, however this allegation is not supported from any document. It is his argument that there is no material to show that the petitioner has instigated or abetted the deceased to commit suicide and the ingredients of Section 107 of IPC are not fulfilled.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would appear as and when called by the Investigating Officer and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Upon instructions received from ASI, Ghanshar Singh, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the FIR, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 06.04.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
