Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.41 dated 9.2.2021 registered under Sections 379, 435, 34 IPC at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

As per allegations in the FIR, some unknown person committed theft of motor cycle Honda CD 110 bearing No.HR14-N-5862 belonging to complainant-Jaivir and thereafter, set ablaze the said motorcycle and the burnt motorcycle was recovered from the fields of Ram Kishan.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order dated 4.3.2022 passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar has not disputed this fact and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation. State

counsel has also not disputed the fact that FIR in this case was lodged against unknown person and recovery of burnt motorcycle of the complainant has already been effected.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 4.3.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
