1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 18.10.2019, in CWP-30139-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 18.10.2019, reveals that CWP-30139-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 28.06.2019, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case it was found that the petitioner was entitled to any monetary benefits, to release the same to him within three months thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondent No.4 has passed order Annexure R/1 dated 09.03.2020, partly accepting the claim of the petitioner and the petitioner has already challenged order Annexure R/1 by way of CWP-27104-2021, to the extent the same denies the full relief claimed by the petitioner, therefore, in the

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant

petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to pursue CWP-27104-2021, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
