Learned State counsel submits that the claim of the petitioner as raised in the present writ petition has already been decided to be released in favour of the petitioner by the respondents and the same will be deposited in the bank account of the petitioner on furnishing details of the bank account number by the petitioner to the authority concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the relevant bank account number will be furnished to the authority concerned within a period of ten days from today.

Learned State counsel submits that within a period of four weeks of the submission of the relevant bank account number by the petitioner, the arrears, for which, the petitioner is found entitled for by the respondents, will be deposited in her bank account.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be

given liberty to approach the respondents, if any grievance of the petitioner will subsist.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner raising any grievance, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present writ petition and the same may be disposed off having been not pressed any further.
