Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents-authorities for sanction of the subsidy as per letter dated 14.09.2005 (Annexure P-1) to the petitioner according to the latest policy/guidelines (Annexure P-5).

Learned State Counsel has referred to Memo No.Inc. Inc.-1/Sub/ASR 5290-A dated 15.11.2022, whereby an amount of ₹14,18,000/- as investment incentive has been sanctioned. A further statement has been made today in the Court by Sh. Bhagat Singh, General Manager, District Industries Centre, Tarn Taran that the above amount of sanctioned capital incentive/subsidy shall be positively released in favour of the petitioner

within a period of three months from today.

In view of the aforesaid specific statement recorded by the General Manager, District Industries Centre, Tarn Taran, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant writ petition, at this stage.

Disposed of accordingly.

Needless to mention that the respondents shall remain bound by the statement so made today in the Court.
