Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.8 dated 17.01.2021, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 326 and 450 IPC added later on and Section 452 IPC Omitted) registered at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Vide order dated 04.03.2021, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

On instructions from ASI Harmeet Singh, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 04.03.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is

made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
