[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.07.2020 in CRM-M No.20353 of 2020 in case titled as Rocky vs. State of Haryana and another.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.20353 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the Superintendent of Jail, Panipat to ensure proper and prompt medical treatment was provided to the petitioner for the injury sustained by him on his right leg.

[3] Learned DAG refers to para Nos.5 to 7 of the reply to contend that prompt action was taken and the petitioner provided medical treatment and that in the circumstances no further action is called for in the matter against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[4] None is present on behalf of the petitioner. For that matter, none was present on behalf of the petitioner on 17.03.2021. It appears

that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the

instant petition.

[5] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as the statement of the learned DAG, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if cause survives.
