SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Without treating it as a precedent, especially given the hard medical conditions besetting the petitioner, this Court directs that the period of parole be extended for a period of 4 weeks.
2. However, immediately upon expiry of the above extended period of parole, the prisoner is directed to ensure his re-stepping into the prison, and, if he does not do so, thereupon the Station House Officer concerned, is directed to cause his arrest, and, ensure his being re-committed to prison.
