[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.04.2021 in CWP No.8072 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.04.2021 reveals that CWP No.8072 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents/competent authorities to examine the claim of the petitioners and to take a final decision thereon against the backdrop of legal notice dated 12.02.2021 within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondents to do the needful.

[4] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, learned AAG, who is present, has produced copy of speaking order dated 30.03.2022 passed by respondent No.3, rejecting the claim made in the

thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge order dated 30.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
