This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The instant petition had been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by the petitioner for seeking various reliefs including transfer of investigation from respondent No.4 to any other officer as the petitioner expressed apprehension that the respondent No.4 has initiated proceedings against him out of oblique motive and mallice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly pointed out that he had also made a representation for transfer of investigation from respondent No.4 to some other Officer and that the said prayer of the petitioner already stands answered by the respondent-authorities.
