The prayer in the present petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to make correction of the place of birth of the petitioner and re-issue passport after such correction.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed and after carrying out the necessary correction, passport has been issued to her and she is in receipt of the same.

Learned counsel further submits that in view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed and the present petition be disposed of accordingly.

Learned counsel for the respondents affirms the aforesaid factum and has no objection to the petition being disposed of.
