[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 01.11.2021 in CWP No. 22172 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 01.11.2021 reveals that CWP No.22172 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to consider and decide representation dated 12.03.2020 by keeping in view the contentions raised in the writ petition within three months.

[3] Learned DAG has filed reply by way of affidavit of the respondent along with speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 16.03.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The reply is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who after perusal of the same states that he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 16.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
