Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.124 dated 11.11.2020 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab.

By virtue of the order dated 7.12.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the matter has also been settled amicably in the Mediation Centre, and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Report dated 29.11.2021 of the Mediator affirming the abovesaid fact has also been received in connected case i.e. CRM-M-8510-2021.

Learned State counsel has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 7.12.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
