This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for directing official respondents to release the petitioner on emergency parole for two weeks, who is undergoing imprisonment pursuant to the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 17.04.2018 passed by Id. Addl. Sessions Judge, Gurugram, in case FIR No.554 dated 26.09.2016, registered under Sections 341, 342, 365, 395, 397 and 384 IPC and Sections 25 Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Sohna, District Gurugram. Further prays that the respondent authorities be directed to decide the representation dated 10.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order.

Learned State counsel has produced the communication dated 14.02.2022 to assert that the representation given by the petitioner for his release on parole stands dismissed.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition.
