**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.286 dated 12.10.2021, under Sections 21, 27-A & 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Parao, District Ambala Cantt.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 10 grams of heroin (non-commercial quantity), cash of around Rs.80,000/- and one mobile phone is alleged to have been recovered from the petitioner. He is 24 years of age and is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act. He is in custody for about 5 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Jaswinder Singh, contends that the challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined. He also contends that the petitioner is involved in several other cases but there is no other case under the NDPS Act against the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the recovery is of non-commercial quantity, the petitioner is 24 years of age, the COVID-19

pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
